Junior Piano Rules

In addition to the General Contest Rules, the following rules apply specifically to the Junior Piano Divisions:

A contestant may enter only one of the following divisions:

PEEWEE—age 8 and under

JUNIOR JUNIOR—age 9-12

JUNIOR—age 13-17

- 2. Each contestant must play two tunes: a classical piece; and a second song from any era, including contemporary, pop, ragtime, jazz, boogie etc.
- 3. **Five minute playing time will be strictly adhered to.** Two points will be deducted from the total score for each ten second interval or portion thereof over the time limit.
- 4. Contestants may not have printed music on stage and will play without accompanists.
- 5. In the event of a tie, each contestant will play one tune of his/her selection that he/she did not play in his/her first round.
- 6. Judging will be by three judges sitting in front of the stage. There will be a maximum of 100 points possible for each tune from each judge. Judging will be based on the following:

Correct notes and Memorization (25 points)

Tempo and Rhythm (25 points)

Tone Production and Use of Pedal (if applicable) (25 points)

Difficulty (25 points)

- 7. The decision of the judges is final.
- 8. Any contestant winning a Piano Division three years in a row may not compete in a Piano Division for at least one year.
